Goode said freshmen would realize good grades would determine his future rank if he lived with the other three classes. Freshmen would start studying hard earlier so they would have a better chance for rank, he said.

Under the committee's plan, a rigid CQ (call to quarters) would be enforced. The committee believes this would also help freshmen and sophomores make good grades. It would abolish the attitude of a small minority who now cause disturbances during CQ, Goode explained. He said he believed all trouble on the campus was caused by a small minority and did not represent the attitude of the majority of students.

He cited the flooding of Ross Hall and the hanging in effigy of Col. Joe Davis, commandant, as examples. Goode said he did not believe members of the junior class took part in these acts.

Oil Men Discuss State Water Supply

What to do about Texas' vanishing water supply is being discussed at the sixth Oil Recovery Conference of the Texas Petroleum Research Committee in the MSC now.

Among the speakers at the conference are Ing F. Hoffman and Walter Ruehl of Weitz, Germany, who will discuss oil operations in their country.

The conference began Wednesday morning with an address of welcome by Gibb Gilchrist, A&M System chancellor. It will close with a forum session this afternoon.

Zinn commended the work of the committee. He said, "We must be doing some good. There have not been as many accidents reported to the hospital this year as in the past.

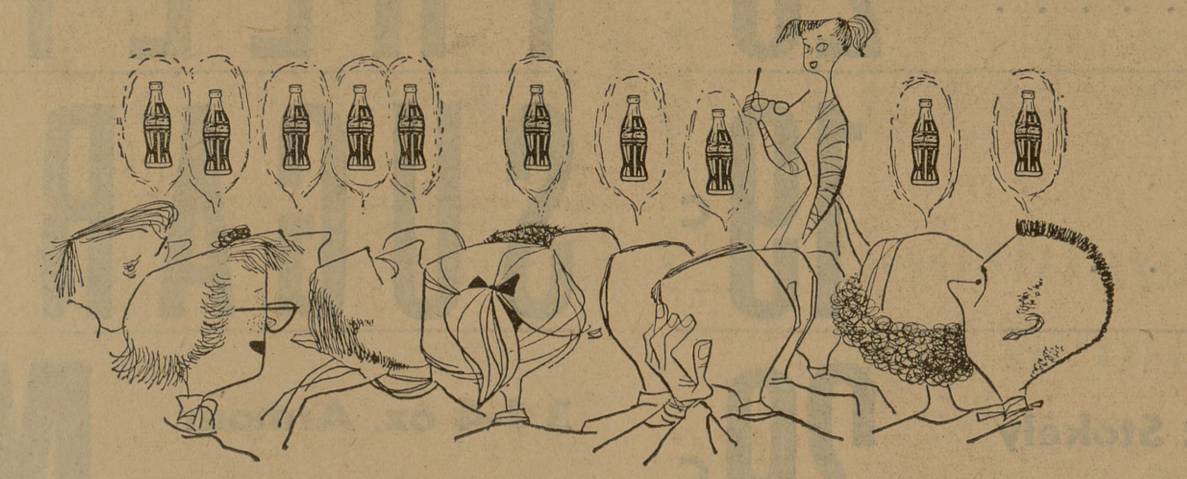
Co-eds, Studies Here for Summer
