Sinclair snared five passes for 93 yards and one touchdown in the Baylor game and put on a bang-up defensive show. Bennie has a season record of 14 catches good for 218 yards, two touch downs and an average of 15.6 yards per catch.

The six feet, 2, junior has a lot of speed, enabling him to get downfield and into the enemy secondary fast. His fine opening jump from the line of scrimmage
