Labor market conditions are good here, according to the Texas Employment commission, because many agricultural workers are employed in the area.

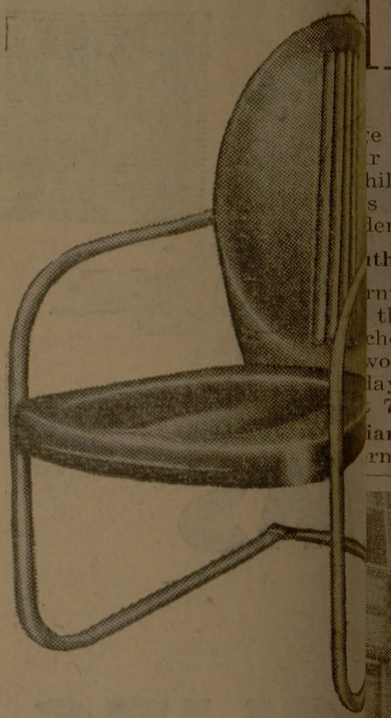
