Other officers are Bob Ruiz, vice-president; Pat Farley, secretary-treasurer, and Jake Harper, recorder.

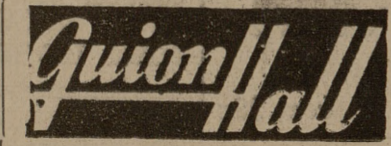

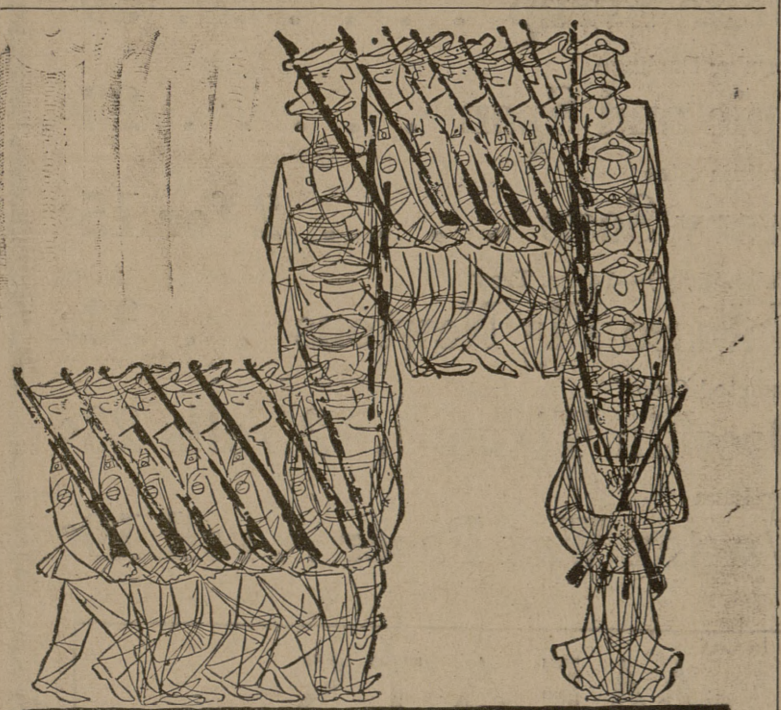
