## A&M Holstein Bull Gets Silver Medal

Pabst Burke Ina, a registered Holstein bull in the A&M dairy herd, has qualified as a silver medal production sire according to standards of the Holstein-Friesian association of America.

Dr. I. W. Rupel, head of the dairy husbandry department said the recognition is based on comparison of production records of the

bull's daughters and those of their dams.

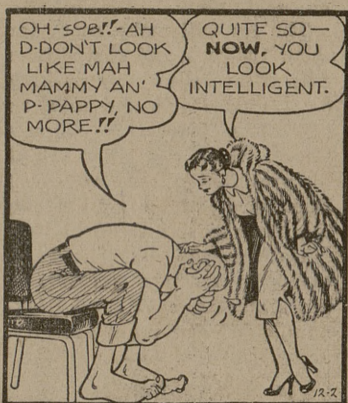
These comparison tests must include records of at least 10 daughter-dam teams, and all records must have been made under official herd improvement registry or advanced registry test supervised by the college in cooperation with the association.
