





Mistletoe Hunters Snipe For Kiss Bait

MOUNT VERNON, Ind .- (AP)-You can buy mistletoe for Christmas kiss bait at a shop or you can get it the way gallant hunters do here-shoot it down yourself out of the treetops.

The parasite green grows so high in elm, black walnut and shellbark hickory trees in the nearby river bottoms that shooting it down is easier than climbing after it. The sharper-eyed hunters use

hollow-point bullets in a .22 caliber rifle, aiming a line of shots that will cut off a limb on which the mistletoe is growing. A choke-bore shotgun is used to
