# Cadets Stress Offense for Razorback Game

Offense was the order of the day as the Aggie varsity stepped through a brisk hour workout yesterday, beginning preparation for their second Southwest conference game—with Arkansas here Saturday night.

The Razorbacks also lost their conference opener—62-67 to title-favorite TCU. Arkansas has defeated the Aggies once this season, 74-70 in the consolation finals of the conference tournament.

Coach John Floyd made two changes in the Aggie lineup which started the Rice game Tuesday night. Bob Gattis, and John Henry, both 6-3½, replaced guard Roger Harvey and center George Mehaffey.

John Fortenberry, Bill Brophy and Lee Smith completed the lineup.

Harvey was badly shaken up in a scramble for the ball in the Owl game and didn't take part in yesterday's practice. Mehaffey worked on the reserves.

Obviously trying to get the Cadets back on their shooting game after the 41-61 loss to Rice, Floyd was at least partially successful. The starting five, after a slow start, sank about 15 of 20 shots at one point, with John Fortenberry dropping in his set shots with regularity. Tuesday night, Fortenberry

and Brophy, the big scoring guns for the Cadets, made a total of only 8 out of 36 field goals. The Cadets, now 2-8 over the season, hit 14 of 71 shots.

Brophy now has 148 points,

a 14.8 average per game. He leads the team in rebounds with 85 in 10 games. Fortenberry has 147 points.

Yesterday, Pat McCrory and Ted Harrod also worked out at

Smith's guard spot, and Don Bilbrey subbed for Gattis and Henry.

Conley Phipps, on last year's Fish team, began workouts. He played on the red-shirted reserve

team through most of the practice period. Floyd said he was on a "trial" basis.

After their 84-53 loss to the Rice Owlets, the Fish also went through a sharp workout last

night under John DeWitt. Fritzie Connley took over the team scoring leadership, his 18 points Tuesday giving him 71 to guard Bryan Sutherland's 65.

One A&M student, freshman Jose Merino, got back to school late from the Christmas holidays because of the assassination of Panama president Jose Antonio Remon.

Merino, a member of the Fish swimming team, went home to Lima, Peru, for the holidays. He left there by plane Saturday night for College Station, stopping in Panama at 2 a.m. Sunday.

After the shooting, the Panama assembly declared a state of seige, and travelers had to remain within the country. Merino spent 67 hours there—until 9 p.m. Tuesday. He arrived here yesterday afternoon.

Merino swam for A&M Consolidated high school last year and was selected on the all-America high school team. He holds the state record for the 100-yard freestyle.

### Handball Club Is Third In Nation

Jim Mathis and Johnny Johnson won first place in doubles to pace the A&M handball club to a third place finish in the national intercollegiate tournament held in Chicago during the Christmas holidays.

Paul Meiners was third in singles. Don Grant was eliminated in the first round of singles play.

Other teams competing were University of Detroit, Illinois, Ohio State, Loras university, Washington university and George Williams university.

Trophies were presented to top performers by Bob Kendler, Chicago millionaire and founder of the U.S. Handball association, sponsor of the tourney. He is a former national singles champ.
