About half of Indochina is forested.

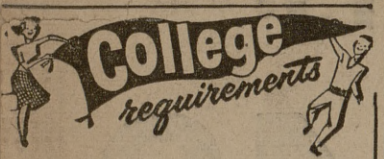

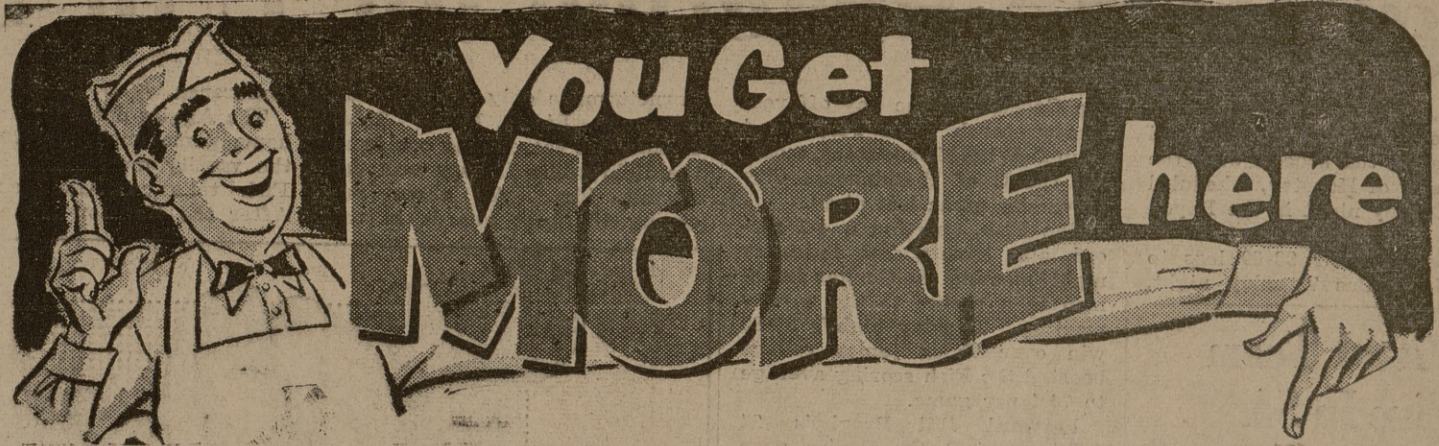
