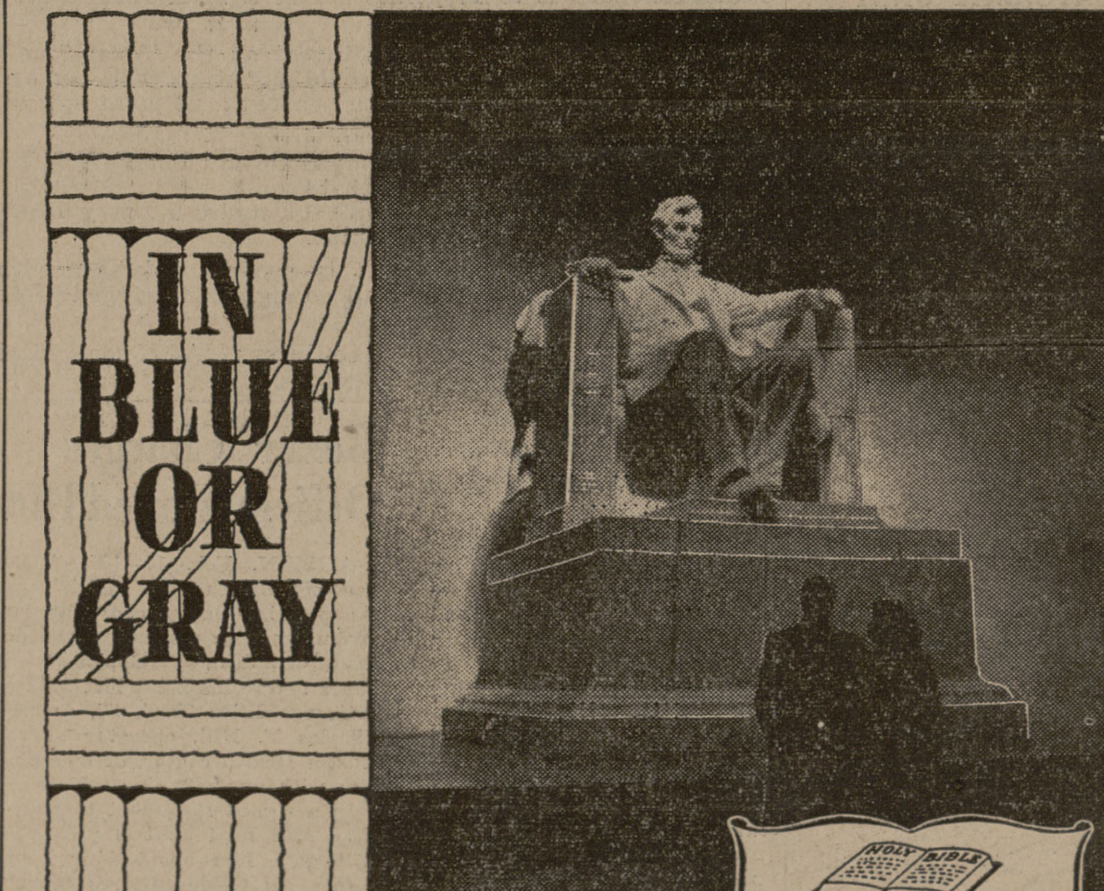
Friday
