Five Aggies Compete In KU Relays

Five A&M trackmen left yesterday for the Kansas Relays scheduled Saturday at Lawrence, Kansas. Coach Frank G. Anderson accompanied them.

Competing for A&M will be hurdler James Hollingsworth, pole vaulter Winton Thomas, high jumper Fritz Connally and weightmen Tom Bonorden and Herman Johnson.

Hollingsworth turned in the fastest time in the nation in the high hurdles Tuesday, a wind-aided 14.0. Thomas had done 13-8 in the vault, Connally 6-4 in the high jump.

Bonorden hit 52-11 1/2 twice and in the shotput Johnson has a 52-9 1/2. It will be the third meet in a week for the quintet.
