> The College Station swimming team racked up 45 points in the women's division and 37 in the men's to take third place in both groups at the Gulf AAU Swimming Championships in Houston last weekend.

> Taking first places for the girls were Ann Schlesselman, who swam the 400-meter freestyle, G a i l Schlesselman, 100-meter butterfly breaststroke, and Martha Shawn in the 100-meter backstroke.

Gail also won second place in the 200-meter breaststroke, and both she and Martha swam on the second-place 266%-meter medley relay team with Mary Frances Badgett and Judy Litton.
