

### B Field Cracks Swim Mark In Intramurals

"B" field artillery bettered a 16-year-old freshmen intramural 300-yard medley swimming record with a sparkling 1:01.2 last night in P. L. Downs Natatorium as 100 teams battled for 20 places in the finals. The old record, 1:01.7, was set in 1939 by "E" field artillery.

300 swimmers competed in Wednesday's quarterfinals. Ten teams in both upperclassmen and freshmen divisions won berths in the finals, to be held next Wednesday night.

Squadron 17 turned in the best upperclassmen time with a 1:01.0. The record in this division is 0:58.2, set in 1950 by "A" Athletics.
