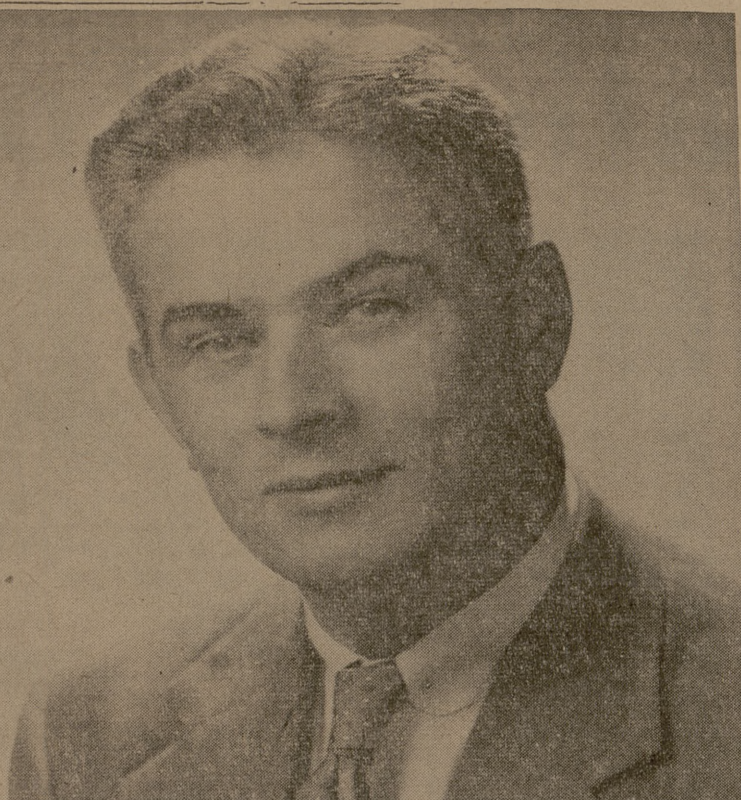

SMU Theologian To Speak Tonight

Dr. Joseph Quillian, of Perkins School of Theology, Southern Methodist University, will be at the YMCA tonight at 9:30 to counsel with any student contemplating full time Christian service.

Dr. Quillian, who is professor of homiletics at Perkins, will be here tonight only to speak to students. All students who are considering the ministry or any of the church related fields as a career are encouraged to attend this meeting.

Born at Buford, Ga., Dr. Quillian received his BA degree from Piedmont College, a BD from Vanderbilt University, and a PhD in philosophical ethics from Yale.

He pastored churches in Tennessee, was chaplain with the U. S. Navy from 1942-46, served as minister of a Stamford, Conn., church and in 1950 became president of Martin College, Pulaski, Tenn. A position he held until he joined the Perkins faculty in September 1954.

Dr. Quillian is a nephew of Dr. Paul Quillian, for many years pastor of the First Methodist Church of Houston.
