Rodney now weighs 29 pounds. He walks but still needs some help. Attendants say his conversation is bright and has been centered on Santa Claus.

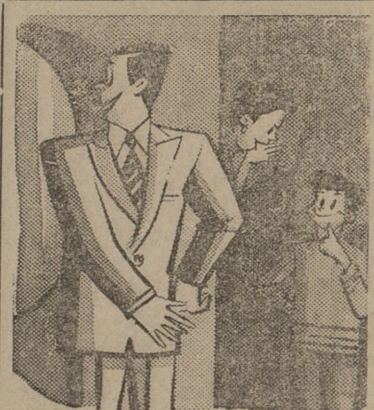
The Brodie family has planned a big Christmas celebration for Rodney.

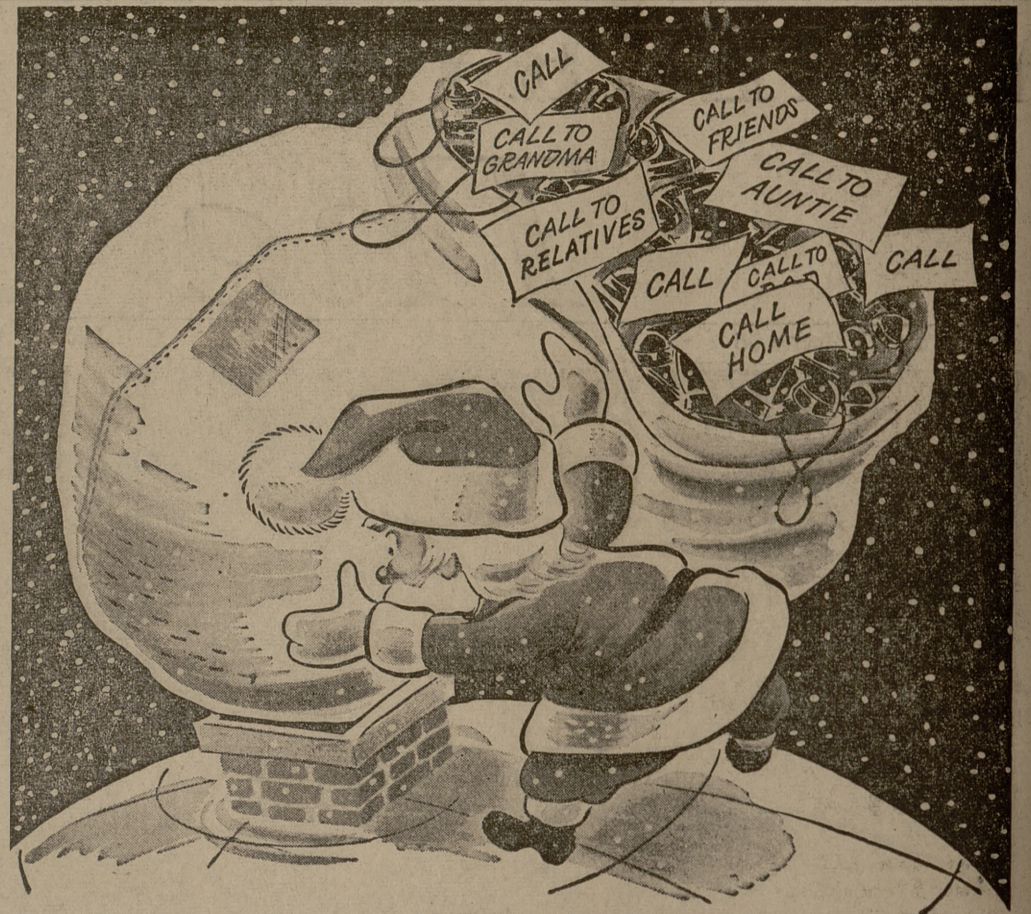
