Traffic School ScheduledHere Feb. 20 - 24

The first annual short school on traffic engineering will be held here Feb. 20-24. The school will be sponsored jointly by the Texas Transportation Institute and the Civil Engineering Department, with the cooperation of the practicing traffic engineers throughout the state. The course is being offered to assist medium-sized cities in the training of personnel responsible for the various traffic engineering functions. Subjects to be covered include

traffic engineering problems, traffic engineering organization, traffic laws and regulations, speed studies, regulations and zoning, traffic surveys and studies, traffic planning, parking, traffic signs, signals and markings, geometric design (streets, intersections, channelization and others).

D. Grant Mickle, director, traffic engineering division, Automotive Safety Foundation, Washington, will deliver the opening address and take an active part in the proceedings.




