PHILADELPHIA - Connie Mack, who helped pioneer baseball from the sandlots to the No. 1 sport in the nation, died yesterday at the age of 93. Known around the world as the grand old man of baseball and one of the most beloved men in the history of the game, Mack-born 23, 1862—died quietly with his wife, four daughters and one of three sons at his bedside. Mack was in baseball 62 years, 50 of them as manager of the Philadelphia Athletics of the American League, a term unequalled in the history of the game.
