## Walton Conducting Graduate Course

A graduate course in Guidance and Counseling at Rosenberg, Texas, taught by E. V. Walton, head of the Agricultural Education Department, is attracting teachers from a wide area.

Designed primarily for teachers of vocational agriculture, the course meets weekly for a period of twelve weeks. Twenty-one teachers are enrolled including high school principals, science teachers, elementary school teachers and vocational agriculture teachers from nine counties.

Purpose of the course is to assist teachers to set up individual counseling programs within their classes as well as to train them in organizing guidance and counseling programs for an entire high school. In commenting on the course,

Walton remarked, "I have been around A&M so long, it is still a bit difficult to become accustomed to having women enrolled in classes, but they contribute a lot to the discussion."
