

Orr's Market Brings Indian Chief Here

Orr's Super Markets in Bryan will have a colorful hereditary Indian Chief, Winnebago Chief Ho-Ton-Ga, making a personal appearance at the local Orr's Super Market where he will be in the local store today through Saturday. His sponsor is Rath Packing Company.

Chief Ho-Ton-Ga is descended from a long line of chiefs, among whom one of the most colorful was his grandfather, Wee-Joo-Kah, who won great respect as a leading member of the Omaha Scouts. The scouts were organized in 1864 from free Winnebago and Cheyenne Indians to protect construction crews of the Union Pacific Railroad from hostile Indian raiding parties.

Chief Ho-Ton-Ga has won acclaim as a featured Indian singer for the past 14 seasons at the Stand Rock Indian Ceremonials at Wisconsin Dells. He was graduated from the Miami University on a musical scholarship. He has appeared in many major cities of the country as a soloist with an all-Indian band. He was a member of the band when it played for the Hoover-Curtis Inaugural Ball in 1928.

W. H. Orr of the local stores said that the chief has agreed to pose for pictures without charge. He suggested that anyone desiring to take pictures bring a camera with flash attachment to his store during the days the chief is present.
