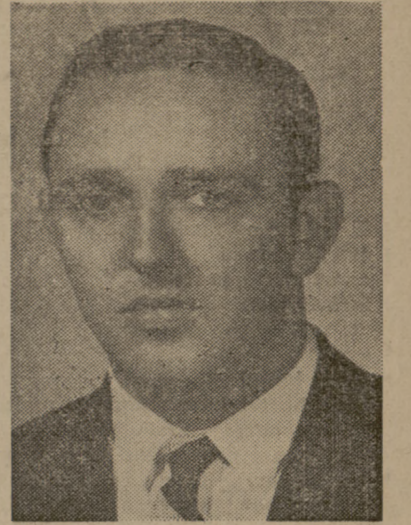
## Newcomer's Club Choose Chairmen

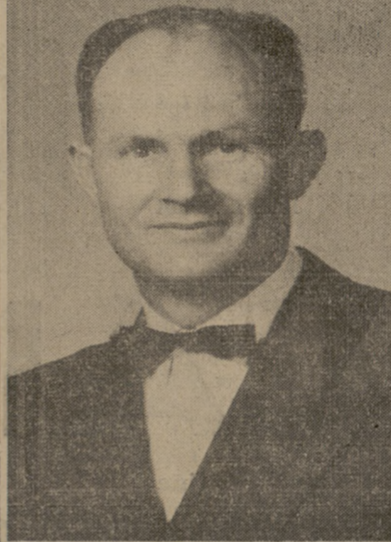

## Local Pastor Takes Leave of Absence

The Rev. Clarence Ketch, pastor of the A&M Christian Church, has been granted a 12 to 15 month leave of absence to complete graduate work, it was announced recently.

Dr. William C. Jones, retired Dallas minister, will act as pastor until Rev. Ketch's return in September, 1957.

Rev. Ketch plans to work on his Ph.D. in sociology and psychology at Louisiana State University in Baton Rouge, La. He will have an assistantship in the sociology department there.

The pastor had planned to leave last year but the church was destroyed by fire March 28, 1955, postponing the leave.
