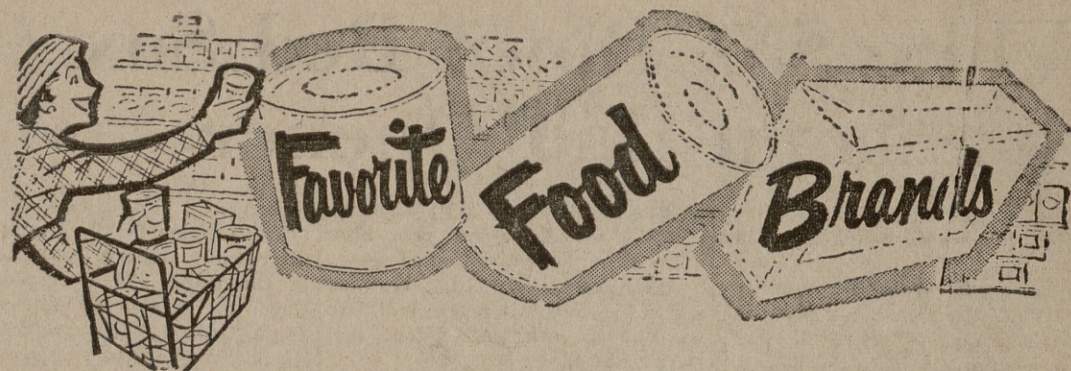
A&M Methodist Church
