### Baptist Aggies Attend BSU State Meet

Jim Manley, promotional director of the A&M Baptist Student Union Executive Council and Corps Scholastic Officer, will serve as a student panel member in the Saturday morning session of the state BSU Convention.

Approximately 3,000 students from the state's colleges and universities are expected to gather at Gaston Avenue Church in Dallas, October 5-7 for the annual convention sponsored by the student department of the Baptist General Convention of Texas, Director W. F. Howard said.

Dr. Theodore Adams, president of the Baptist Alliance and pastor of the First Church in Richmond, Va., will be one of the main speakers. Others include Dr. Baker James Cauthen, executive secretary of the Foreign Mission Board; Dr. Chester Swor, lecturer and author; Dr. Culbert Rutenber, professor of religion at Eastern Seminary in Philadelphia, Pa.; William Hall Preston, association of the SBC Student Department; Dr. Herbert Howard, pastor of Park Cities Church, Dallas; and Prentice Chunn, pastor of First Church in San Marcos.

Theme, Special Music  
Theme of the convention will be "Christ, the Lord—My Lord!" A&M students participating in the program are Manley and Dub Bailey. Bailey, president of the A&M BSU Executive Council, will be convener of the Saturday afternoon session.

The 100-voice state BSU choir, directed by John Preston of Baylor University, the Baylor Dental College chorus, directed by Gale Dunn of Gaston Avenue Church, and soloist, David Taylor will present special music. Don Dixon and Ben Trotter are Aggies in the state choir.

Presentation of summer mission work done by Texas students in other lands, Christian home emphasis, testimonies from mission volunteers, and a "student-to-student" campus sharing session will be among other features of the program.

Registration for the convention sessions begins Friday at 10 a.m. Sessions start at 7 p.m. Friday and will end before the morning worship service on Sunday.

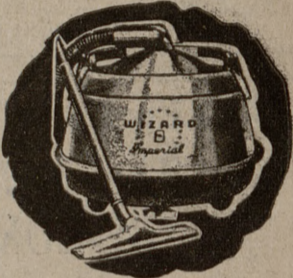
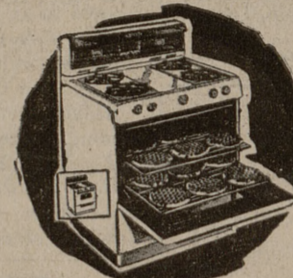
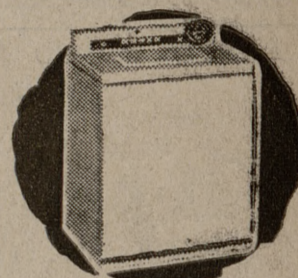
