sion of a Christmas party, to be held jointly with the Fish and Game Club, will be one of the main orders of business.

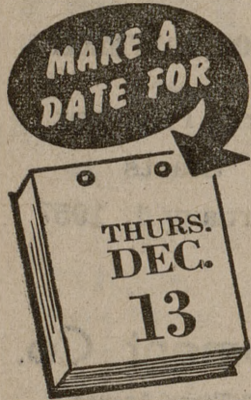
