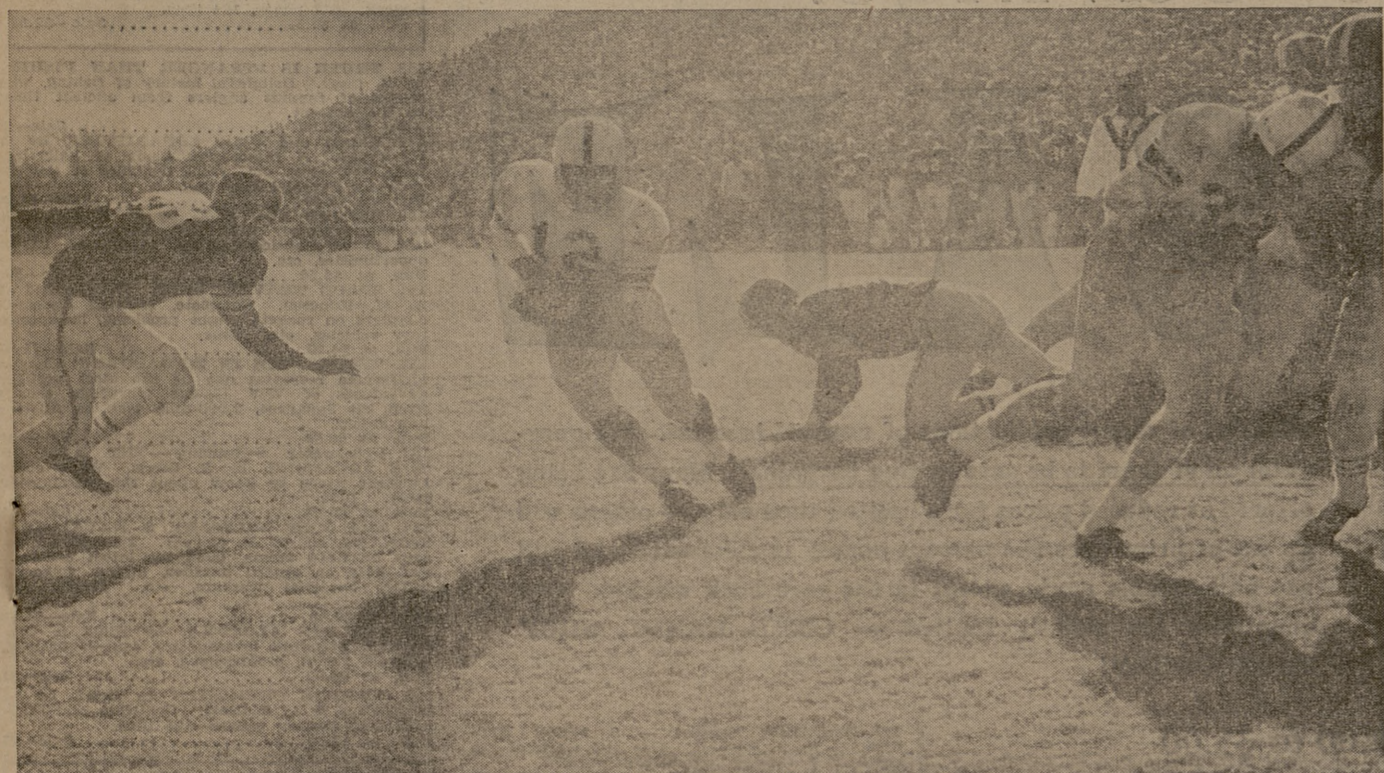
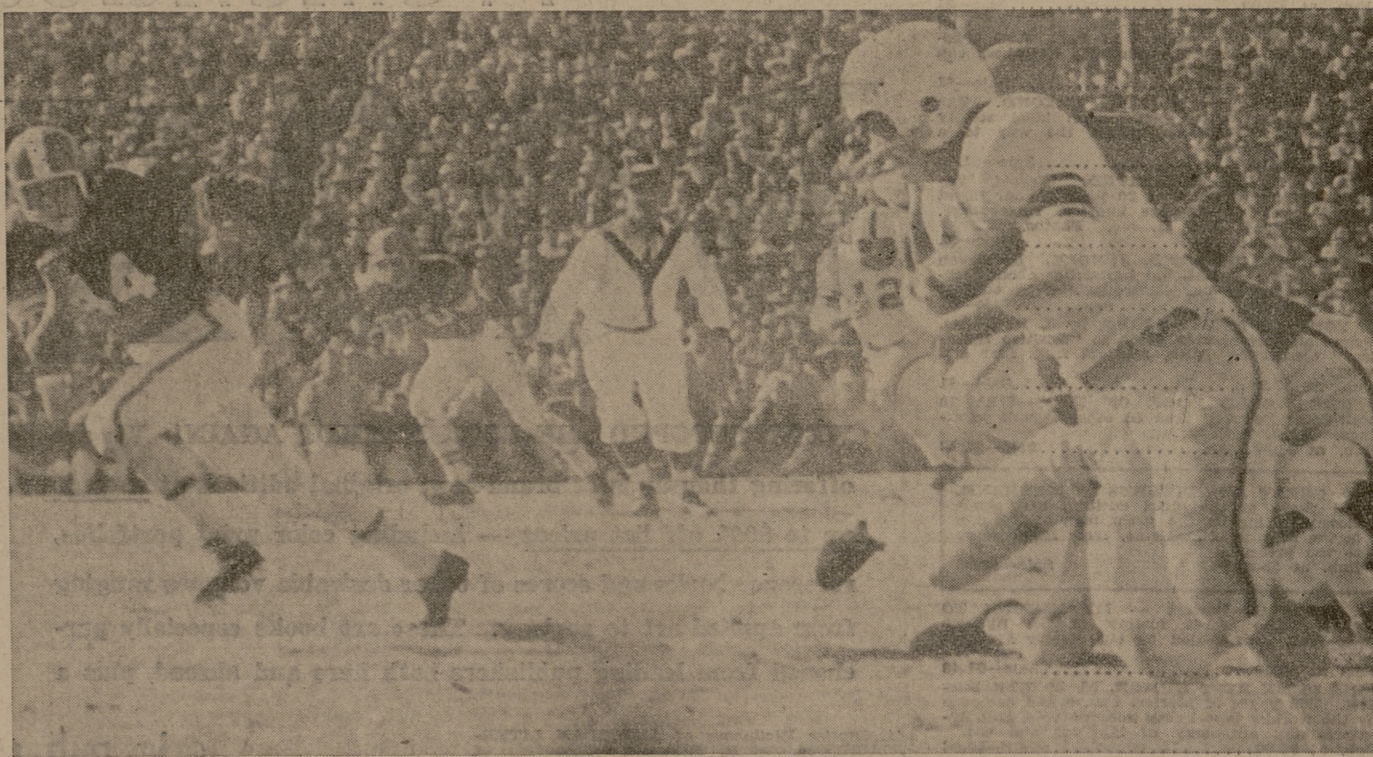


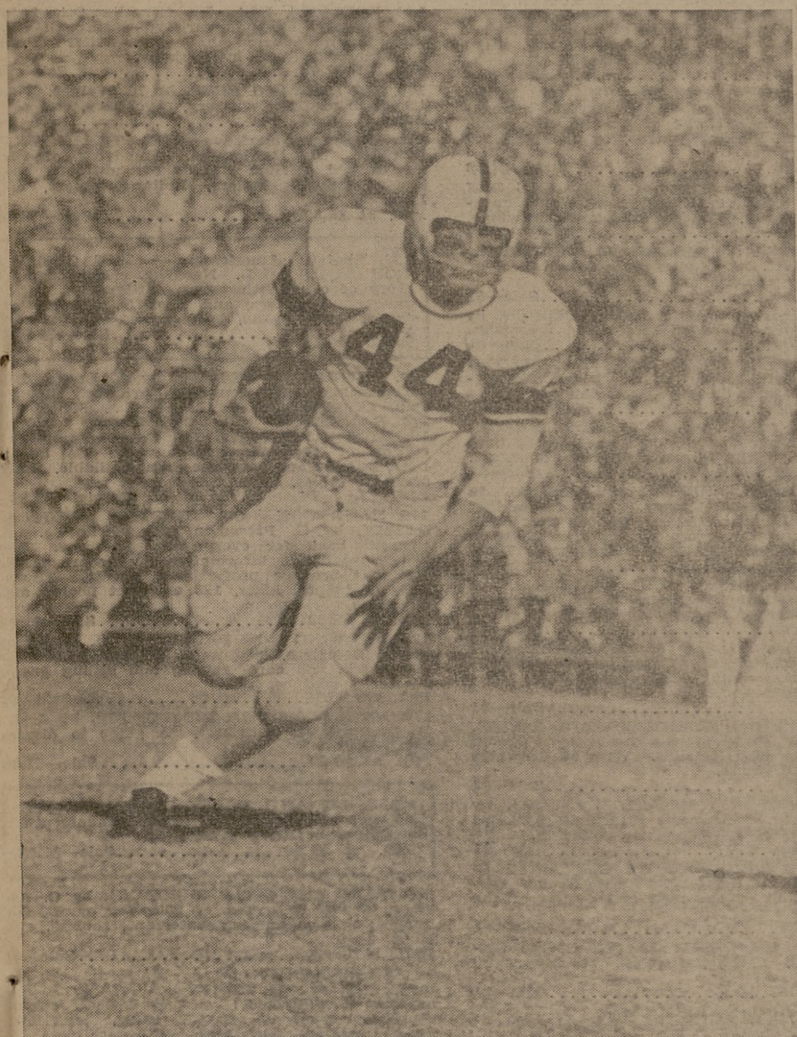
Fighting Aggies Couldn't Be Denied



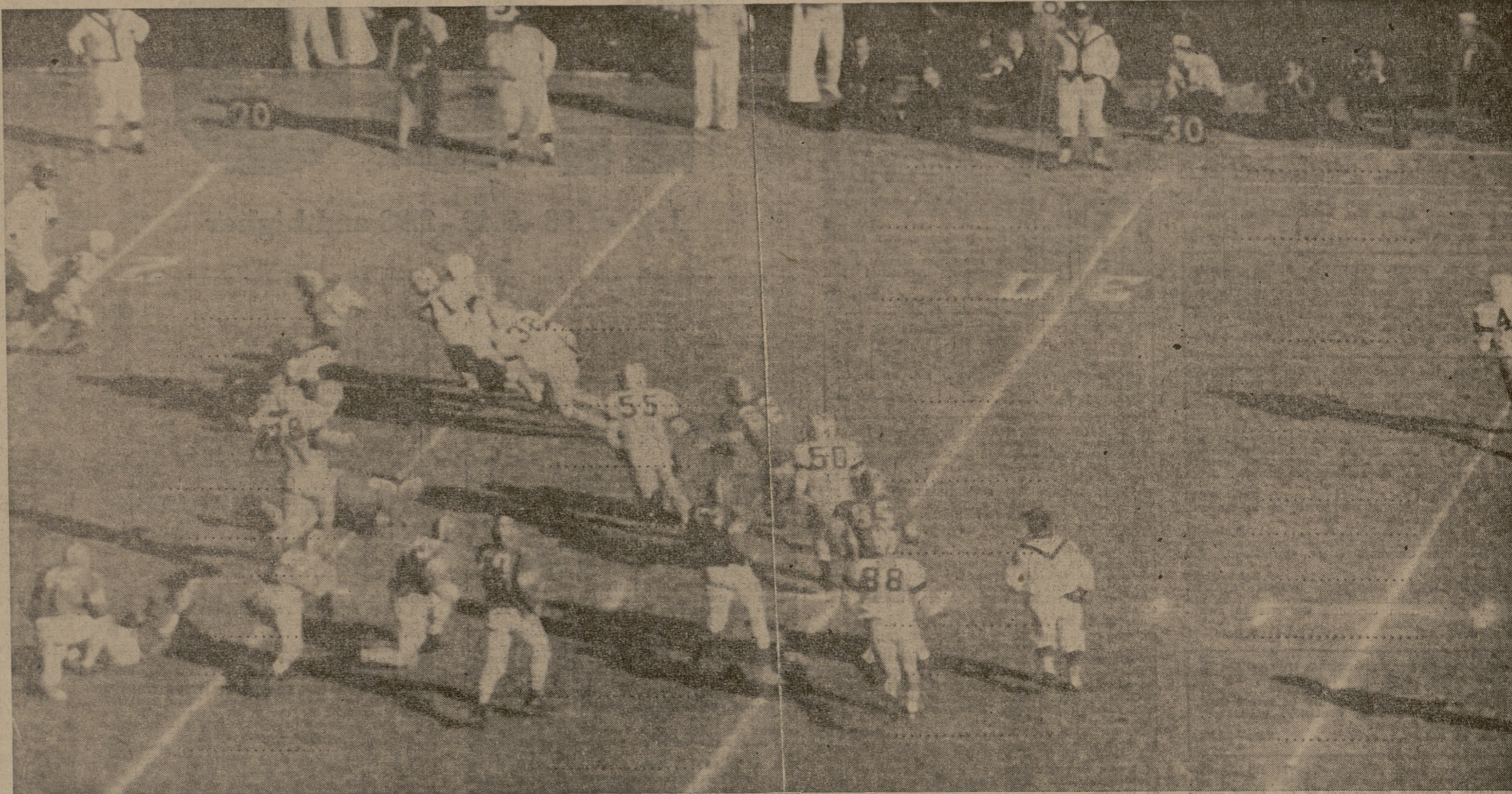
