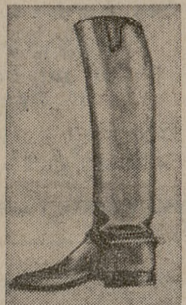
B'NAI BRITH HILLEL FOUNDATION
