

Gilchrist Approves State Water Plan

(P)—A&M's water research center director, Gibb Gilchrist, yesterday voiced faint approval of the proposed 200 million dollar Texas water bond plan but said the state's water program is now on a "sand foundation."

He said more important is the statewide water plan proposed by Gov. Price Daniel for submission to the Oct. 14 special session of the legislature.

"Without having laid the solid foundation on which an adequate water for Texas program must rest, we still insist on building parts of the structure first, Gilchrist told more than 100 conferees at the closing of the third annual Water for Texas Conference.

Voicing mild support for the 200 million dollar water reservoir financial aid program, Gilchrist said, "It's purpose is good. It's much better than building nothing."

But he emphasized what he called three specific requirements still unfulfilled. He said they were:

1. The legislature should create a single responsible body to pass on all matters of finance and administration for a Texas water program.

2. Texans should be given the chance to vote on a constitutional amendment authorizing an ad valorem property tax for statewide planning and continual organization.

3. Put a value on water. It should be neither cheap nor free. "It is my firm conviction that if the people of Texas ever got to vote for a tax to promote water for Texas and with adequate and truthful facts before them, they will vote 'aye' overwhelmingly," he said.

Praising Daniel's efforts as a step in the right direction, Gilchrist said the governor was "showing a great earnestness to do something about a plan."

Under the proposed constitutional amendment, a state water development board of six members would be created.

Bangkok Monarch Shuffles Leaders

BANGKOK, Sept. 18 (P)—King Phumiphon Aduldet last night invested Thailand's new strongman army Marshal Sarit Thanarat with legal power and shuffled the membership of Parliament.

The monarch named Sarit military custodian of Bangkok. Sarit headed the military junta that drove out Premier P. Pibulsonggram Monday night.

The deposed Premier disappeared and there were reports that the ruling junta is inviting him back home with promises for his personal safety.

The King dissolved the old Parliament and appointed 123 new representatives who are to serve until new elections can be held within three months.

The old Parliament had 283 members, of whom 160 were elected. The 123 appointed legislators

are to run the national body until the remainder can be elected.

The King's selections were made on recommendations from Sarit's ruling junta.

They include Prince Wan, foreign minister in the old Cabinet and ex-president of the U. N. General Assembly; and Field Marshal Pinolunhawan, former defense minister and father in law of Police Gen. Phao Sriyanond, who left the country for Switzerland.

Actually, up to 99 per cent of the King's new appointees are believed to be holdovers from the last Parliament. Several former police officers were among the nominees.

The King's decree stressed that the 1932 constitution remains in effect.

There was no indication when a new Cabinet will be named.
