Arkansas, not impressive in a

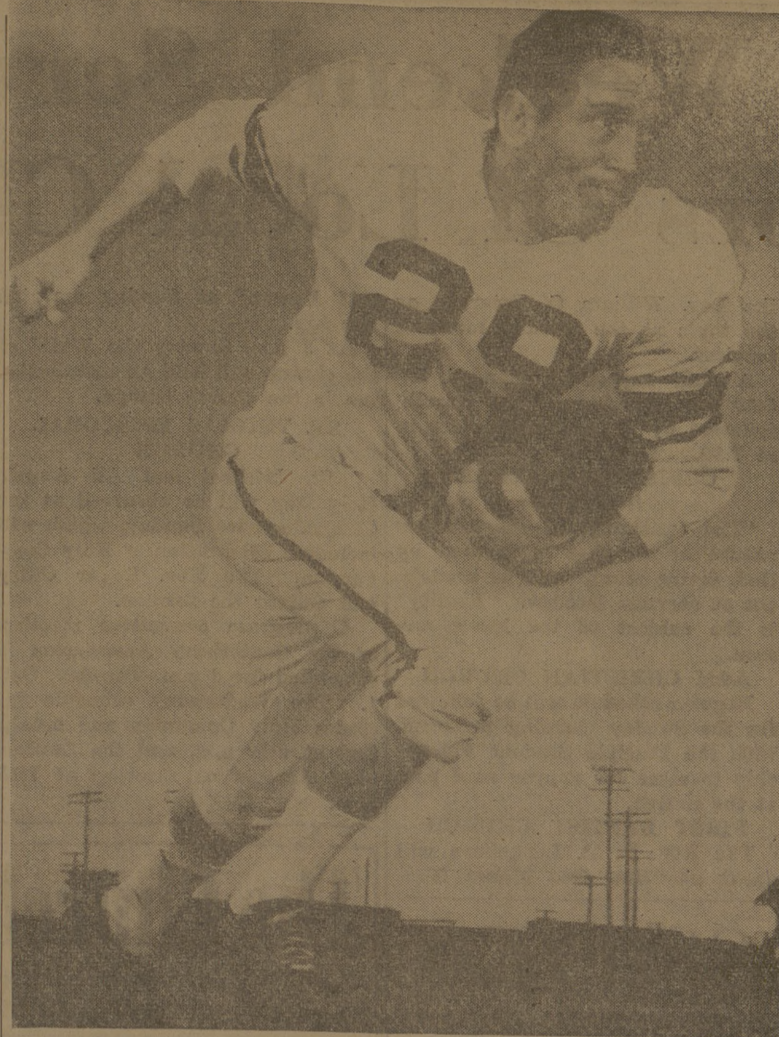
