

Bonfire, Aggie Practice Beckon Rain

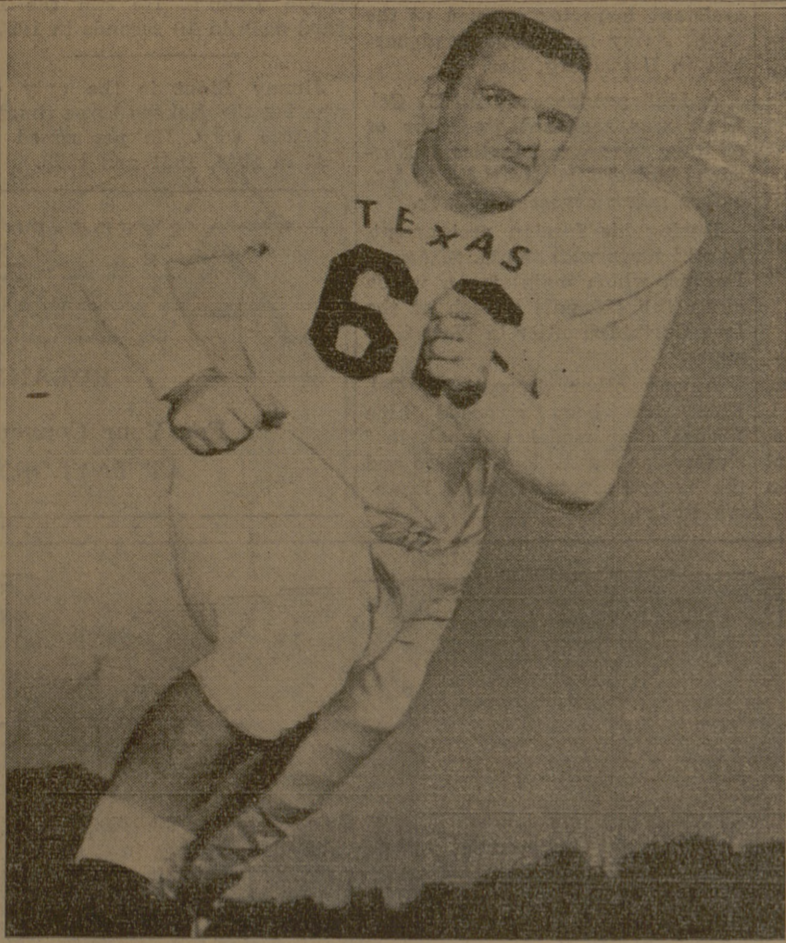
TU To Play In Sugar Bowl?

The Dallas News said tonight it had learned the University of Texas has received unofficial feelers to play in the Sugar Bowl and the Gator Bowl on New Year's Day.

The Longhorn's bowl hopes, however, appear to depend on the outcome of their game with Texas A&M on Thanksgiving Day.

Ed Olle, athletic director, said: "If we beat Texas A&M, we have a good chance of receiving a bowl bid."

Coach Darrell Royal said: "It would be a nice reward for the boys, but we are the underdogs against A&M and we won't be in any bowl picture if they beat us."

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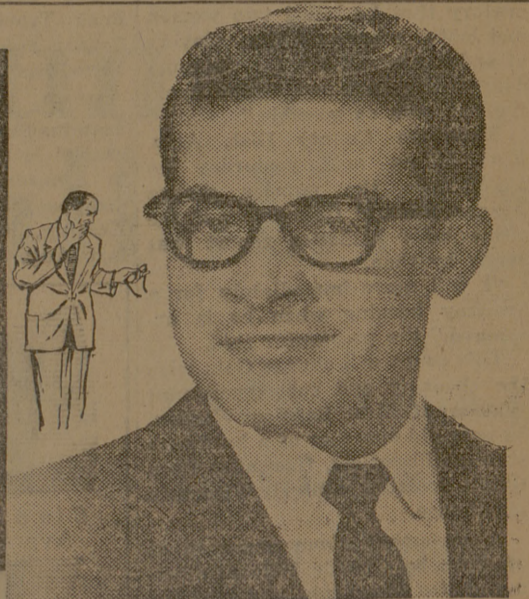
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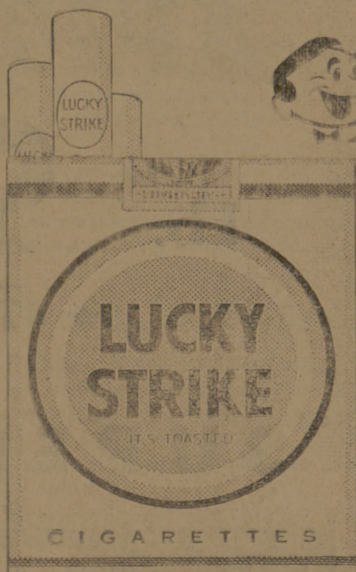
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
