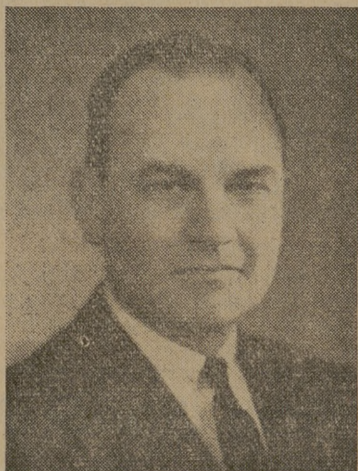

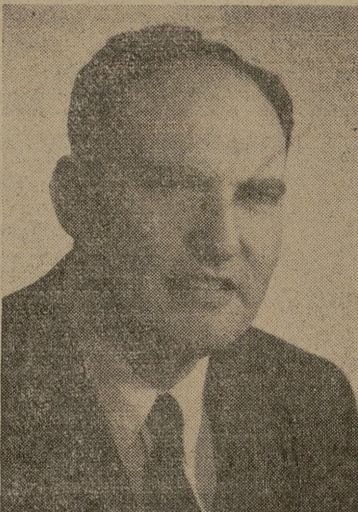

From time to time observer chairs will be empty and students are encouraged to fill these vacancies. However the observing students will not be permitted to enter into the discussions.



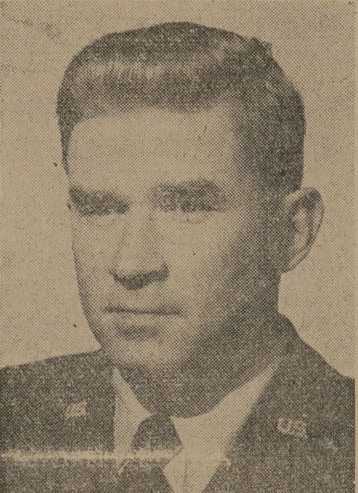

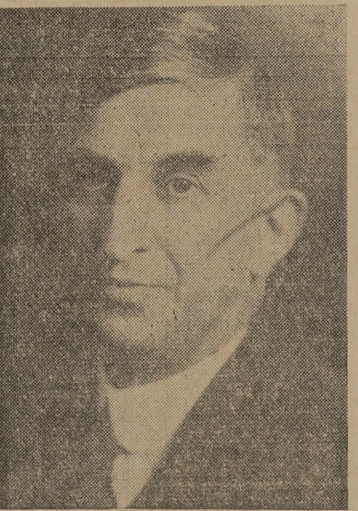
