Myers' assistants were scheduled for increases ranging from \$250 to be called a do-or-die game for the \$750. However, if Myers comes to feathered ones. Aggieland, he is expected to bring his coaching staff with him.

Myers expressed belief earlier in the week that he would be recommended for the job next Monday, and went so far as to name his coaching staff-which is to include J. T. King and Willie Zapalac, both assistants from the former regime.

The Texas A&M Board of Directors will not convene until Monday, and it is not beyond imagination that A&M will have their prospective coach snatched "from under their noses" once again.
