ORANGE CAKE

1 cup butter or shortening
 2 cups sugar
 4 eggs
 1-1/2 cups buttermilk
 1 teaspoon soda
 Cream butter or shortening and sugar. Add eggs, one at a time, then other ingredients as listed. Mix and bake 1 1/2 hours at 250 degrees.
 For the filling, mix 1 cup orange juice and 2 cups sugar and let stand until dissolved. Pour over cake, while hot, a little at a time, rubbing in until all is absorbed.

GUACAMOLE DIP

2 ripe avocados
 1 teaspoon onion juice
 1 teaspoon lemon juice
 Mash avocados with fork and add seasonings. Use as a dip. This may be used as a dressing.

EGGPLANT CASSEROLE

1 large eggplant
 1 pound ground meat
 2 tablespoons parsley
 1 small onion
 1/2 cup milk
 Peel and dice eggplant and cook until tender in boiling salted water. Sauté onion in 1 tablespoon butter; add meat, salt and pepper to taste. Cook until browned well. Mash cooked eggplant and add parsley. Add eggplant mixture to meat.
 Melt 3 tablespoons butter and stir in crackers until butter is absorbed. Place layers of eggplant and meat and layers of cracker crumbs alternately in baking dish with layer of crumbs on top. Pour milk over these ingredients. Sprinkle paprika and cheese on top. Bake in 375-degree oven for half an hour.

CREOLE FRANKS

3 tablespoons butter
 1/2 cup chopped green pepper
 1/2 cup chopped onions
 1 minced clove garlic
 1/2 cup raw rice
 1 No. 2 1/2 can tomatoes
 1 tablespoon sugar
 6 frank
 1 1/2 teaspoon salt
 1/2 teaspoon pepper
 1 bay leaf
 3 whole cloves
 Brown pepper, onion, garlic in skillet. Add rice, tomatoes, sugar salt, pepper, bay leaf and cloves. Cover. Simmer 30 minutes. Top with frank. Cover, and simmer an additional 5 minutes.
