The film, dealing with the 16th century monk who defied excommunication and the stake in his demand for religious reform, was produced by Louis de Rochemont Associates.

Title role is played by Niall MacGinnis, British actor, who heads a cast and crew of 500 from the U. S., France, Ireland, England, Scotland, Germany and
