He was born Nov. 25, 1881, at Sotto il Monte, in the Province of Bergamo, a center studded with churches 30 miles northeast of Milan. His was a family of modest farmers.

Angelo Giuseppe Roncalli was just 21 years old when he entered the diocese seminary at Bergamo, Twelve years later, Aug. 10, 1904, he was ordained a priest in Rome's Santa Maria in Monte Church.

World War I interrupted his ecclesiastical career briefly. He first served as a sergeant in the medical corps of the Italian army. By the time the war ended he was an army chaplain.

The war over, Father Roncalli returned to Bergamo for a threeyear term as a lecturer on theology and church history.
