A public utility short course for electrical metermen will be conducted by the Department of Electrical Engineering Nov. 3-7.

The short course is sponsored by the manufacturers of electrical power demand meters, the public utilities of Texas and the EE department. The course headed by Prof. Norman F. Rode covers the basic fundamentals of electricity and theory of operation of watthour meters.

The course is divided into two parts for beginners and advanced metermen. The classes will be taught by representatives of each of the sponsors.

Registration will begin Nov. 3, at 9 a.m. in the Memorial Student Center. The fee is \$12. A banquet will be held Nov. 6, at the MSC.
