tion along a 21/2-day journey to- high by 14 inches long. ward the moon. 2. Provide data on the intensity and extent of magnetic fields

of the earth and the moon. 3. Report the number of impacts with meteorites.

4. Scan the far side of the moon with a television type device and relay to earth impressions that would be converted into crude photographs.

Also like those in the most recently launched probe, the 25 pounds of instruments aboard the new space traveler will be thoroughly sterilized 24 hours before blastoff, against the extremently remote prospect that it might actually hit the moon.

Scientists have agreed to make every effort to avoid lunar contamination until after earthmen have had a chance to explore the moon's virgin surface.
