Not only do such actions as this hurt the basketball team, but it also damages the reputation of the school and its students. It takes only one incident caused by some unthinking student to damn the school for years.

Schools that have resorted to physical violence during form the District of Columbia on athletic contests have been heavily censored by the press in which to locate the national seat the past.
