

Agricultural Experiment Station Given Aid To Support Research and Studies

During the past month seven grants-in-aid, an extension of a grant, two gifts and four loans of equipment, livestock or materials have been made to the Texas Agricultural Experiment Station to support research studies in several fields.

Director R. D. Lewis said two of the grants were made to support studies in the Department of Entomology. The Shell Chemical Corp. has made available \$2,300 for studies of the effectiveness of various toxicants against insects attacking cotton and vegetables.

The Department of Poultry Science will do research on the growth of chicks and poulters under a grant of \$2,500 made by E. R. Squibb and Sons.
