

# Local Churches Welcome Aggie Participation

Local churches welcome the participation of the Aggies in their various programs.

In addition to the regular schedule, many churches sponsor activities designed especially for the student community.

Following are brief descriptions of the coming weekly schedules of the churches and the activities set.

**A&M Methodist Church**  
Sunday worship will be conducted at 9:45 and 10:55 a.m. and at 7 p.m. under the direction of the Rev. James Argue. Also set for Sunday is a supper from 5-6:30 p.m., followed by a discussion program. Wednesday the Wesley

Foundation will meet from 7-8:15 p.m. and vespers are conducted each night from 7-7:20 p.m. except when Yell Practice is set. Communion will be held Friday morning at 6:30 a.m. followed by breakfast and discussion.

In addition freshman fellowships will be held twice monthly and the Wesley players, a religious drama group, will give one or more plays this year.

The Methodist Student Movement on the A&M campus is the Wesley Foundation, staffed by two ordained ministers of the Methodist Church. It carries on a full program of activities aimed toward

the interests and abilities of the individual student. The Foundation is located in a frame building on the grounds of the A&M Methodist Church.

Special events include weekend retreats, state and national conferences and parties. A full church school program is offered with college-age groups led by local members under the supervision of the Wesley Foundation.

Musical activities are under the direction of Bill Turner, director of the Singing Cadets. And under the Methodist Church structure, it is possible for students to become affiliate members of their college church, while retaining membership in the churches in their home communities.

**Our Saviour's Lutheran Church**  
Worship services will be held Sunday at 8:15 and 10:45 a.m. with a special church school class for Aggies scheduled for 9:30 a.m. Wednesday the Lutheran Student Assn. will meet at the Lutheran Student Center, located at Main and Cross Streets in College Station.

Programs, under the direction of the Rev. Edwin Svenson, include worship, study and recreation, with the Women's Missionary Society serving refreshments. Special events, in addition to the regular meetings, will also be sponsored during the year.

**A&M Christian Church**  
Sunday School will be held at the regular time, 9:45 a.m., with the worship service set for Sunday at 11 a.m. Disciples Student Fellowship will meet at 5 p.m. Sunday for program planning.
