### Nurses School Starts Classes Next Week

The Bryan School of Vocational Nursing is scheduled to begin its classes Tuesday, according to Mrs. John W. Huff, teacher in the school.

Tuition for the course is \$50, according to Mrs. Huff, and the Bryan hospitals will pay \$45 a month while women are in school.

Entrance requirements are two years of high school or its equivalent, a minimum age of 18, good physical and mental health moral integrity and ability to get along with others.

Rooms for the school are being prepared at the Travis Elementary School, and applications are now being accepted.

They may be submitted to the Bryan School of Vocational Nursing in care of the administrators of either Bryan or St. Joseph's Hospital, or Stephen F. Austin High School.

Mrs. Huff is a graduate of the Dallas School of Nursing. She served one year as a surgical staff nurse, two years as an instructor in professional nursing and four years as a public school nurse.

Mrs. Huff said the class could accommodate 21 to 25, but that all of these have not been selected.
