Rogers Worried Over Cagers; Not Progressing Fast Enough

(Spl)—Aggie Basketball Coach Bob Rogers is perturbed over the progress his cagers have made in the 10 days since workouts started but he hopes they'll come around before the opener five weeks from now.

The Aggies open play Dec. 1

against Centenary at College Station with a short club that has good shooters and more speed than Rogers' two previous A&M teams.

"They're not thinking enough basketball off the floor," Rogers said this week, "but I hope it's the time of year that's causing it."

The Aggie mentor, who produced A&M's first winning team in eight seasons last year, figures he will have more speed and quickness which will improve the defense.

Although still lacking the big player, the Aggies have good balanced height. Wayne Lawrence,

senior from Pawcatuck, Conn., is the tallest at 6-7. Soph Carroll Broussard of Port Arthur and John Keller of Terrell are 6-5 while the others are from 6-0 to 6-4.

The Stanley twins, Pat and Don of Buna and Kilgore Junior College, along with Broussard and Lawrence have looked good offensively to date while on defense Wilmer Cox, Houston senior and Wayne Annet, junior college transfer from Paris JC, have been impressive.

Rogers is giving a good look to Tommy Smith, 6-2 hold-out sophomore from Jefferson.

"Tommy is potentially a good ball player but he needs more aggressiveness and a continuous all-out effort," Rogers said. "I'm hoping it's the result of the lay-off last year. At any rate, a little blood on his nose could cure his trouble and make a good player out of him."

All SWC Squads Open Play Dec. 1

Every Southwest Conference basketball team but one opens season play December 1. The lone holdout is the Southern Methodist Mustangs.

The Aggies open against Centenary at College Station; Baylor against Howard Payne at Waco; Arkansas tangles with the Phillips "66" teams at Bartlesville, Okla.; Rice meets Trinity at San Antonio; Texas tries McMurry at Austin; TCU meets S. F. Austin in Fort Worth and Texas Tech stays at home to face New Mexico University.

TCU is the defending conference champion.
