Petroleum Course In Progress Here For Two Weeks

The latest methods of evaluating performances of petroleum reservoirs are being studied here at the third Advanced Petroleum Reservoir Engineering Course.

Representatives of some 15 major and independent oil companies comprise the student body. The representatives are from Venezuela, California, Louisiana, Oklahoma, Mississippi and Texas.

The information gained at the course may be used as a basis for selecting field operating procedures to achieve optimum recovery. Prof. R. L. Whiting, head of the Department of Petroleum Engineering, said today.

The course will last for two weeks

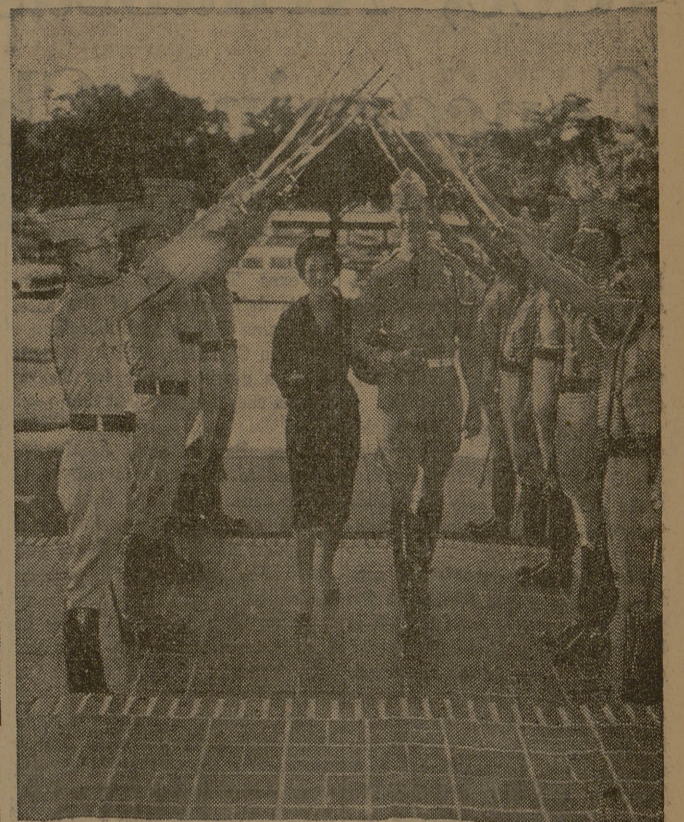

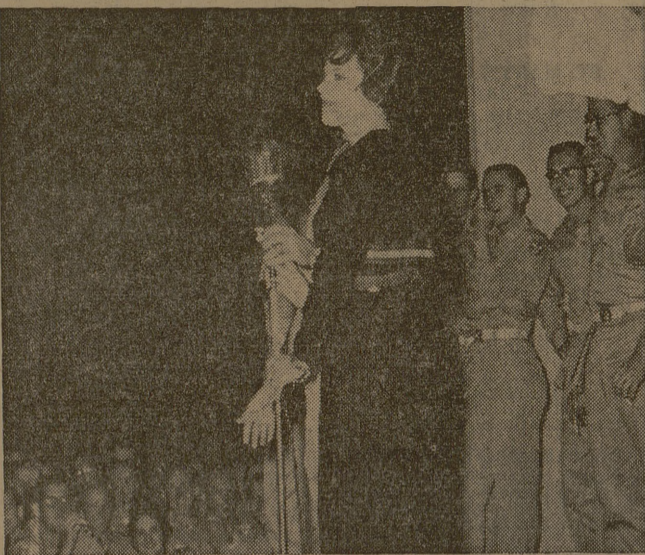

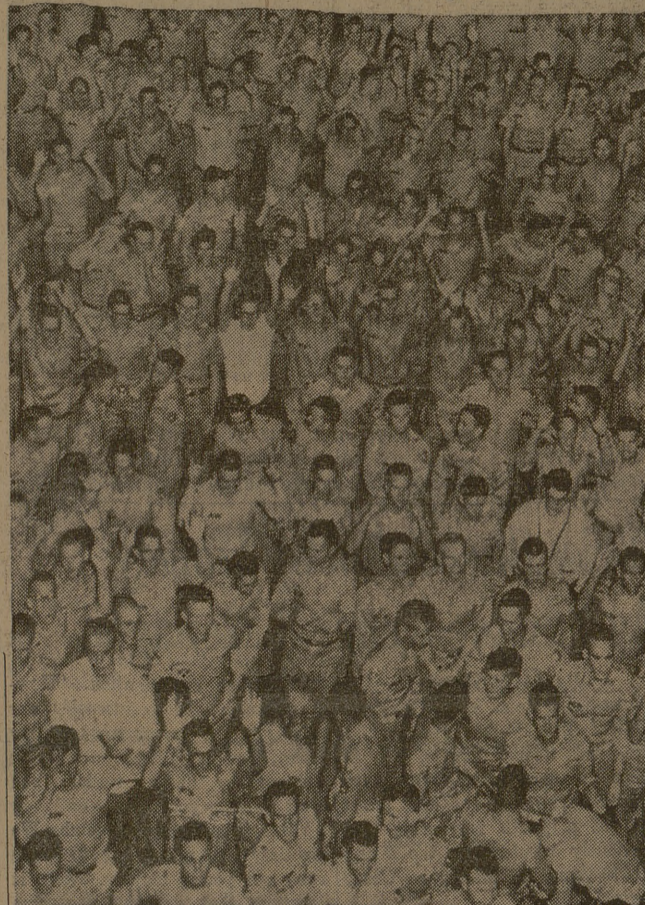
