

Busy Weekend Scheduled For Athletes, HS Students

Two tennis meets, the final intrasquad spring training football game and a triangular track meet are at-home features this weekend for A&M athletes.

The gridiron and track events will be held Saturday as a part of A&M's annual High School Day, when hundreds of students from various parts of the state will visit Aggieland.

Coach Omar Smith's netmen will face tennis players from Abilene Christian College Wednesday and from Pan American College of Edinburg on Friday.

Saturday's track meet, featuring Coach Charlie Thomas' Aggies, Rice and LSU, will begin with field events at 1:30 p.m. and races at 2 p.m.

It will mark the end of four weeks of grid drills.

In previous games this year, the A&M team lost twice to Athletic Blue Stars, and won over Mexico and Shell. All of these teams are from Houston.

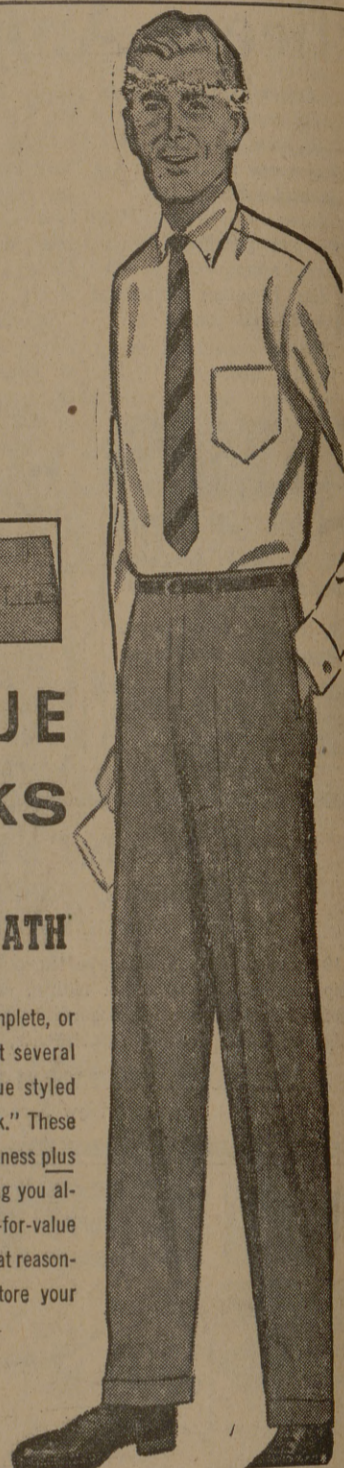
A&M's next game in College Station is a double header with Shell and Mexico and will be Mar. 26.
