

Aggie Tracksters Travel to Austin

Both varsity and freshman track teams travel to Austin today to compete in a triangular meet with the University of Texas and Rice.

Due to injuries the varsity missed the Drake Relays last week but as things look now all muscles are healed and everyone will be ready.

Jim Long, who threw the javelin over 200 feet last year, has been out most of the season with a pulled rib muscle and will not see action anymore this spring.

Sprinters Robert Clark and Ed Williams have both been hampered with pulled muscles most of the season but seem to be in good shape now.

Curtis Roberts will carry to Austin a time of 9.5 in the 100-yard dash and E. L. Ener, who holds the school record in the one-mile run, will take a time of 4:14.6 with him.

Kenneth Rippstein has the top times for the Aggies in both hurdle races with times of 15.0 in the 120-yard highs and a 24.5 in the 220-yard lows.

In the field events Gail McDaniel has cleared the bar in the pole vault with a vault of 13-4, Don

Deaver has high jumped 6-6 and Charles Tiemann has thrown the shot 50-9.

So far this season the varsity has battled the Rice Owls twice in triangular meets and have beaten them both times.

The Fish will be making their second trip to Austin for a triangular meet. They met the University of Texas and the University of Houston earlier in the season.

Pat Mitchell has added several wins to his record this year by taking first place in the 100-yard dash in the Austin and Houston triangular meets with a time of 9.7. He also won the 220 with a 20.9.

Thomas Burns holds top honors for the Freshmen in both hurdle races with times of 15.0 in the 120-yard high hurdles and a 24.1 in the 220-yard lows.

Big Danny Roberts is still in the lead for the Fish in the shot put with a toss of 54-1, also in the javelin with a throw of 187-5 and in the discus with a throw of 151-9½.

Both teams will be preparing themselves for the big Southwest Conference Meet which is coming up next weekend in Houston.
