Texas has received the first South-wide forest fire prevention award for its outstanding reduction of woods fires from July, 1960, through June, 1961, David A. Anderson of the Research Education Department of the Texas Forest Service announced today.

Dr. A. D. Foweiler, director of the Texas Forest Service, accepted the Sam Beichler award at the annual conference of the Southern State Foresters in Atlanta last

A reduction of 62 per cent in forest fire occurrence over Texas' previous five-year average indicated that the state had a highly effective forest fire prevention
