## Nurserymen Will Appeal Products Tax Problem

ciation plans to take its problem ing on nursery products, Vandy- plants. They also tour of ad valorem taxes on nursery griff said. products to the Texas Supreme Court through an application for Writ of Error.

The nurserymen heard a wide variety of talks on the problems and progress of landscaping and the Texas Nurserymen's attion.

Alvis Vandygriff of Austin, attorney for the nurserymen, said Monday that a recent appellate court decision from Amarillo called for "nursery products" to be lifted out of their tax-exempt agricultural classification and placed under ad valorem taxes.

Vandygriff was a speaker at the 25th annual Conference for Texas Nurserymen and Landscape Horticulturists last weekend.

The ad valorem classification, he said, would open the door for cities, counties and school districts to levy taxes on growing "nursery stock." Nurserymen want to keep their products in the agricultural category and will carry the fight to the State Supreme Court.




