

Short Courses Are A&M's Discovery

The office takes care of all bookkeeping and after the course is completed sends out a balance sheet to the sponsoring group. Courses offered for this school year ranged from a clinic for commercial egg growers to an atomic energy conference. There are such courses offered in horse management, plant protection, insect control and city police operation. The number of short courses has grown to the point that a major problem of the short course office is to keep traffic flowing in and out of meeting rooms and housing accommodations by dovetailing dates of the sessions.

Students Must File For Degree By June 15

Brazilians Visit A&M For Study

A&M is serving as host to six Brazilian specialists who are making a comprehensive study of American education and agricultural methods. The group consists of national and state administrators and supervisors of special vocational agriculture schools in Brazil. They are here to learn of the administration, philosophy, principles, techniques and facilities for vocational agriculture in this nation with the expectation of adapting and applying this knowledge to their individual situations back in Brazil.

The visit is sponsored by our government's Agency for International Development with the cooperation of the U. S. Department of Agriculture, and several state agricultural colleges and universities, including A&M. The visitors will be in this nation for approximately four months, leaving Washington, D.C., for Brazil Sept. 15. They came to A&M and Texas from the Washington-Maryland area.

Attendance at the sessions last year varied from 1,657 for the women's training course to 7 for short course on turkeys. Records, says F. W. Hensel, assistant director of placement and special services, indicate the first such session was the farmers short course which started in the early 1900s. Still, the short course office does not handle all the courses, Hensel. The Engineering Extension Service conducts its own conferences and the Agricultural Extension Service handles many of its courses. A majority of the courses are organized by the schools within A&M and are staffed by faculty members. The functions of the short course office are multitude. It conducts registration, makes name tags, collects fees, writes receipts, sells tickets to dinners, provides schedules and helps with housing.
