The deadline for filing applications for National Science Foundation Cooperative Graduate Fellowships is Nov. 1, Coleman M. Loyd, coordinator of the A&M NSF Program, announced Tuesday.

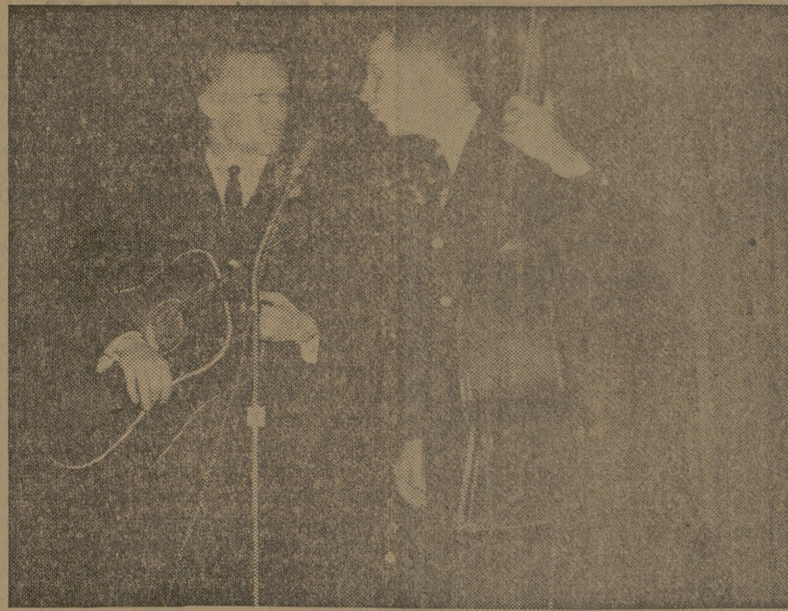
Applications for the 1962-63 academic year fellowships must be filed with the dean of the Graduate School by Nov. 1 in order to become eligible.

The fellowships will be awarded for study or work in the mathematical, physical, medical, biological and engineering sciences; anthropology; economics; geography; the history and philosophy of science; psychology; and sociology.

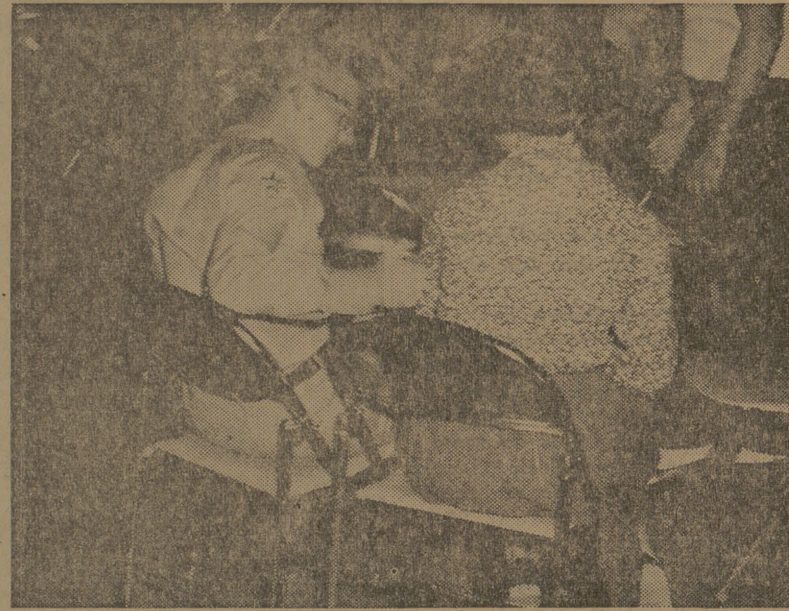
