

Bell Communication Satellite Scientist Will Speak Here

Dr. John R. Pierce of Bell Telephone Laboratories and Telstar fame will be one of the main speakers at the A&M Century Study Convocation Nov. 16.

The scientist will discuss "Space Communication" during the School of Engineering portion of the overall convocation program.

Pierce's name is closely connected with Telstar, the communication satellite developed by the American Telephone and Telegraph Company. Bell Telephone Laboratories are affiliated with AT&T. The scientist was the first in this country to suggest use of space satellites for communications and

to analyze designs of such a system.

He was born at Des Moines, Iowa, and educated at the California Institute of Technology.

Pierce joined Bell Telephone Laboratories in 1936 and became director of electronic research in 1952 and director of research in electronics communications in 1955.

Morning sessions of the convocation include open house and speakers in the schools of engineering, agriculture, arts and sciences and veterinary medicine.

GOP Sees Increase, Demos Predict Sweet

AUSTIN (AP) — Texas Republicans say the 1963 Legislature will include a goodly number of their party members.

State Democrats contend the next lawmaking session will be all-Democrat, erasing the two current GOP members.

An Associated Press sampling of legislative campaigns throughout the state shows more than a dozen hotly contested races between Democrats and Republicans. An upset here and there would not be unexpected.

However, Democrats hold the upper hand in a big majority of

the 13 contested races in the 31-seat Senate and the 84 contests for the 84 seats in the 150-member House.

"I think we'll get a minimum of 10 seats in the House, including the two present Republicans up for re-election, plus maybe one senator," said Tad Smith, acting state GOP chairman.

"WE ARE confident of a complete slate of Democratic legislators," said Clyde Johnson, executive director of the state Democratic headquarters. "That includes the two present Republicans who were elected in special

elections by not more than

cent of the voter strength." Both sides agree the Senate race likely will be a tie between former State Jim Bates, Edinburg Democrat, and McAllen Mayor Ed Barnes, a prominent Republican. Current representative Bates appears to have the edge.

An interesting Senate race because of name similarity, Moffett-Moffitt campaign in atorial District 23. Long George Moffett, Chillicothe Democrat, is challenged by five Republican, Mrs. George Moffitt, Wichita Falls. The latter is the favorite.

ANOTHER NAME in the Harris-Harris race in the Fred Red Harris, winner of campaign for the Democratic nomination, is favored by Republican, O. H. Ike for state representative.

The two incumbent Republican House members have active opponents but are given good odds of re-election.

Rep. George Korins, Democrat City, has a close race with Democrat Don Brown of Brownsville, who is John Cameron County campaign manager. Observers give Korins an upset if he carries Cameron County.

Other close House races turned up in the (AP) included:

Rep. Menton J. Murray, Democrat House member Harlingen, and Fausto Yarr Brownsville, who was John Cameron County campaign manager. Observers give Murray an upset if he carries Cameron County.

IN DALLAS COUNTY, Democrat Henry Stollenwerk is a chance against Democrat T. Higginbotham Jr. and Republican P. Macatee against Corbin Burnett if GOP electoral candidate Jack C. Dallas County.
