

A&M To Host Spring Meet For District 19AA Friday

A&M will host high school students from A&M Consolidated, Cameron, Rockdale, Navasota and Hearne for the District 19AA Interscholastic Spring Meet Friday and Saturday.

19AA District students may enter the meet in their respective age divisions. Events to be held are track, golf, volleyball, tennis and playground ball. Finalists will go to the Regional Meet at Blinn Junior College in Brenham on April 19 and 20.
