

# Armed Forces Day Set For Saturday

Army and Air Force exhibits, including nuclear Army weapons and a fighter fly-by, will make Saturday's Armed Forces Day open the largest and most colorful ever staged in Bryan-College Station. Capt. Alvin Jones, coordinator of this year's observance, said.

Several pieces of equipment have been added to the show including "Honest John," new mobile artillery piece capable of bearing nuclear warhead, he announced.

OTHER WEAPONS "imported" from Ft. Hood for the exhibits are a jeep-mounted 106mm recoilless rifle, a drone target aircraft and a flame thrower.

The latest model infantry rifle, the M-14, and the M-60 machine gun, both adopted for use by NATO forces, will also be on display, he said.

The captain said an Army helicopter and a second L-19 observer aircraft had been added to the air displays at Easterwood Airport. Both open house areas will open at 1 p.m., Capt. Jones said.

# Engineers Create Advisory Council

A six-man advisory council has been organized in the School of Engineering "to generate and develop broad ideas for improvement and development of the School," Dean Fred J. Benson announced Friday.

The council, composed of professors from various fields of engineering, will recommend policies that will enable the school to "better serve the educational needs of people of Texas."

Professors serving on the council include Alan B. Alter, mechanical engineering; Charles A. Rodenberger, aeronautical engineering; Philip T. Eubank, chemical engineering; Charles H. Samson, Jr., aeronautical and civil engineering, and John S. Denison and Harley C. Dillingham, both electrical engineering faculty.

The new advisory council members were elected by popular vote of the engineering faculty. Twenty persons were nominated. The council also will advise the dean on matters of basic importance to the engineering faculty, according to the group's by-laws. Two new members will be elected annually to serve for a three-year period.
