"Anybody who has a song and thinks it's good enough, sends it in. If we don't care for it, we write and say we're sorry but we didn't think it was my type of

"We've done songs from people that live in little towns you never heard of. They send in dubs - records they make dubsit in the office and listen. They usually don't send in music, so we pick what we like and write it down.
